How can this be Your plan?" This storm threatened to consume her and her entire family. "Where are you, Lord? I can't see you, Lord." Becky joined this choir a decade later, in 2023, and through music and community, she finally began the healing process. She discovered she could once again praise the Lord, knowing He was there before, after, and surrounds her still.

"How Great Thou Art," is a song that is truly all about the praise of God. This was the signature song of the Billy Graham crusade at Madison Square Garden in 1957, sung over 100 times, a testament to its enduring power.
