We stand here in victory!



## Chorus

### POWER

Left "s" hand, palms facing in, with left arm bent at elbow. Right "c" hand, palm in, fingers facing down, is placed on upper left arm over the biceps.

### IN

Beginning with the right flat "o" hand, fingers pointing down, above the left "c" hand, palm facing right, move the right hand down and insert the right fingers in the "c" fingers. **Hint: Putting something inside another thing.**



### TRUST

Beginning with the right "c" hand somewhat above the left "c" hand, palms facing in opposite directions, bring the hands downward toward the body while closing into "s" hands, ending with the little-finger side of the right "s" hand on the index-finger side of the left "s" hand. **Hint: Holding on to something with trust.**



### PROMISE

Beginning with the extended right index finger pointing up in front of the lips, palm facing left, move the right hand down while changing to an open hand, ending with the palm of the open right hand on the index-finger side of the left "s" hand held in front of the chest, palm facing right. **Hint: Bringing words down to seal them in a contract.**


*The Lord lives! Praise be to my Rock! Exalted be my God, the Rock, my Savior!"*
