FINISH

Bring both "5" hands in front of the chest, palms facing up, downward with a twist of the wrists, ending with the palms facing down. **Hint: This sign indicates an action is finished or complete.**



CHANGE

With the palm side of both "A" hands together, right hand over the left, twist the wrists, ending with the left hand over the right hand. **Hint: Turn something inside out.**



FORGIVE

Brush the fingertips of the bent right hand, palm facing down, with a repeated movement from the heel to the fingers of the open left palm held up in front of the body. **Hint: Brushing aside a mistake.**
